

ABOUT NEET (National Eligibility cum Entrance Test) :

NEET 2019 (**National Eligibility cum Entrance Test**) will be organized by the CBSE, prescribes certain eligibility criteria to be met by the applicants. It is the only national level medical entrance exam. It is organized for providing admission

in MBBS, BDS courses offered by all Indian Private and government Medical colleges. In order to get admission in medical courses in abroad, candidates have to qualify the NEET UG exam. This exam is conducted once in a year through pen paper mode.

NEET 2019 Application Form:

Candidates should fill the application form as per the instructions given in the information bulletin. Below we are providing details:

- The application form will be issued through online mode only.
- No application will be entertained through offline mode.
- NEET UG registration 2019 will be commenced from the first week of February 2019.
- Candidates should upload the scanned images of recent passport size photograph and
- signature.
- After filling the application form completely, a confirmation page will be generated.
- Download it.

- There will be no need to send the printed confirmation page to the board.

Application Fee:

- General and OBC candidates will have to pay Rs. 1400/- as an application fee.
- The application fee for SC/ST and PH candidates will be Rs. 750/-.
- Fee payment can be done through credit/debit card, net banking, UPI and e-wallet.
- Service tax will also be applicable.
- Category Application Fee
- General/OBC :1400/-
- SC/ST/PH :750/-

NEET UG Application Correction:

One time opportunity will be provided by the board to make correction in the applications.

Details regarding NEET application correction are mentioned below:

- Corrections can be done only through online mode.
- Correction facility will be provided in the third week of March 2019.

- Candidates will be intimated through e-mail/SMS regarding correction in photograph and
- signature. The same will be available in the candidate's login account.
- Candidates can also make corrections in particular fields like:
 - Date of birth
 - Identification Identity
 - Gender
 - State code of eligibility
 - Category
 - Medium of exam paper
 - Disability status
 - Examination Center
 - Qualifying Examination Code & Percentage (%) of Marks Obtained in Class 12th
 - Parents Name (Father's & Mother's)
- In case of any additional fee, candidates can pay through debit/credit card and net banking.

NEET UG Eligibility Criteria

Students must check their eligibility before filling the application form. Candidates can check the detailed NEET 2019 eligibility criteria from below:

Age Limit:

- Candidates must have completed the age of 17 years.

- The maximum age limit will be 25 years (30 years for SC/ST & OBC).

Nationality:

- Indian Nationals, Non Resident Indians (NRIs), Persons of Indian Origin (PIOs), Overseas
- Citizen of India (OCIs) & Foreign Nationals are eligible to apply for NEET UG.
- Candidates belong to J&K state will be eligible to apply for 15% All India Quota on the basis
- of self declaration.

Aadhaar Card Mandate:

- Aadhar number is not mandatory to apply for NEET exam.
- J&K, Assam & Meghalaya candidates can also apply by providing their passport number,
- ration card number, bank account number or any other valid Government ID number.
- NRI candidates can apply by Aadhaar Card number or Passport Number.
- PIO, OCI & Foreign nationals candidates can apply by Passport Number.

Qualification Eligibility:

Qualifying Exam: Students must have passed 10+2 or equivalent exam.

Appearing Candidates: Students appearing in the qualifying exam are also eligible.

Subjects: In the qualifying exam, students should have physics, chemistry, biology/bio-technology with English as compulsory subject.

Percentage Criteria: Minimum 50% marks for general, 45% marks for PH and 40% marks for SC/ST candidates in the PCB group.

NEET 2019 Exam Pattern

Below we are providing the details about NEET 2019 exam pattern:

- **Date of Exam:** The exam will be organized in the first week of May 2019.
- **Mode of Exam:** The exam will be organized through pen and paper based (offline)
- **mode.**
- **Type of Questions:** There will be objective type questions in the exam.
- **Duration:** The exam duration will be of three hours.

- Number of Questions: Total 180 questions will be asked.
- Language: The question paper will be asked in Hindi, English, Gujarati, Marathi, Oriya, Bengali, Assamese, Telugu, Tamil, Urdu and Kananda languages.
- Marking Scheme: For each correct answer, four marks will be given.
- Negative Marking: For each incorrect answer, one mark will be deducted.

NEET UG Answer Key 2019

The answer key will be released along with OMR responses through online mode. NEET answer key 2019 will be published within a week after the exam. The board will offer the facility to challenge against the answer key. Candidates will have to pay Rs. 1000/- per answer to challenge the answer key. Candidates will have to visit their login

portal. Enter their user ID (registration number) and password to challenge the answer key.

NEET 2019 Result

- Here we are providing details about the NEET 2019 result:
- Students those will appear in the exam can check their result viaonline mode.
- Result will be announced in thefirst week of June 2019.
- It will not be prepared category wise.
- There will be no provision of re-evaluation/re-checking of the answer sheets.

NEET UG 2019 Rank List:

- The board will prepare a merit list as per the guidance of DGHS, MCI and DCI.
- The merit list will be prepared for the15% All India Quota.
- Students will be invited for counseling as per their rank in the NEET UG examination.

NEET Counseling 2019:

- The counseling process will be organizedthrough online mode.
- Counseling for15% All India Quota seats will be administrated by Medical Counseling Committee of the Directorate General of Health Services.
- State level counseling will be organized separately by the respective state counseling authorities.

- NEET 2019 counseling will be commenced from the second week of June 2019.
- Firstly, candidates have to register for counseling and fill their preferences for admission.
- Seats will be allotted to students as per their merit, category and availability of seats in colleges.
- Once a seat is allotted, candidates have to report to the allotted college within the notified schedule.
